SECOND NOTICE

There continues to be an ongoing safety concern within the community regarding children and adults operating motorbikes, electric bikes, minibikes, and other motorized vehicles on sidewalks, common areas, open spaces, trails, and other shared community property. We have received numerous reports that these riders are not yielding to pedestrians, are failing to stop at stop signs, and are not following basic traffic safety rules.




Several owners have commented that we should simply "let kids be kids." Unfortunately, that is not an option when community members are being knocked over, injured, or placed at risk by unsafe operation of motorized vehicles.

For the safety of all residents, we encourage anyone who witnesses motorized vehicles being operated in violation of applicable laws or regulations to file a report with the El Paso County Sheriff's Office.

Reports can be submitted online through the Sheriff's Office crime reporting system. Multiple reports help law enforcement identify patterns, locations, and individuals involved. File a Crime Report Online – El Paso County Sheriff's Office

Please note that many motorized vehicles are not legal for operation on public roads unless they meet state requirements and are properly licensed, registered, and equipped. Because these vehicles must often travel on public roadways to access community open spaces and trails, operators may be subject to enforcement by local law enforcement agencies.

Attached are informational documents to assist residents in identifying and classifying various types of motorized bikes and vehicles. We appreciate everyone's cooperation in helping keep our community safe for pedestrians, cyclists, and all residents. Specialized, Unconventional, and Other Vehicles | Department of Revenue - Motor Vehicle

 <b>CLASS 1</b> A "Class 1 electric bicycle," or "low-speed pedal-assisted electric bicycle," is a bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling, and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches the speed of 20 miles per hour.	 <b>CLASS 2</b> A "Class 2 electric bicycle," or "low-speed throttle-assisted electric bicycle," is a bicycle equipped with a motor that may be used exclusively to propel the bicycle, and that is not capable of providing assistance when the bicycle reaches the speed of 20 miles per hour.	 <b>CLASS 3</b> A "Class 3 electric bicycle," or "speed pedal-assisted electric bicycle," is a bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling, ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches the speed of 28 miles per hour, and is equipped with a speedometer.

### E-Bike or E-.....

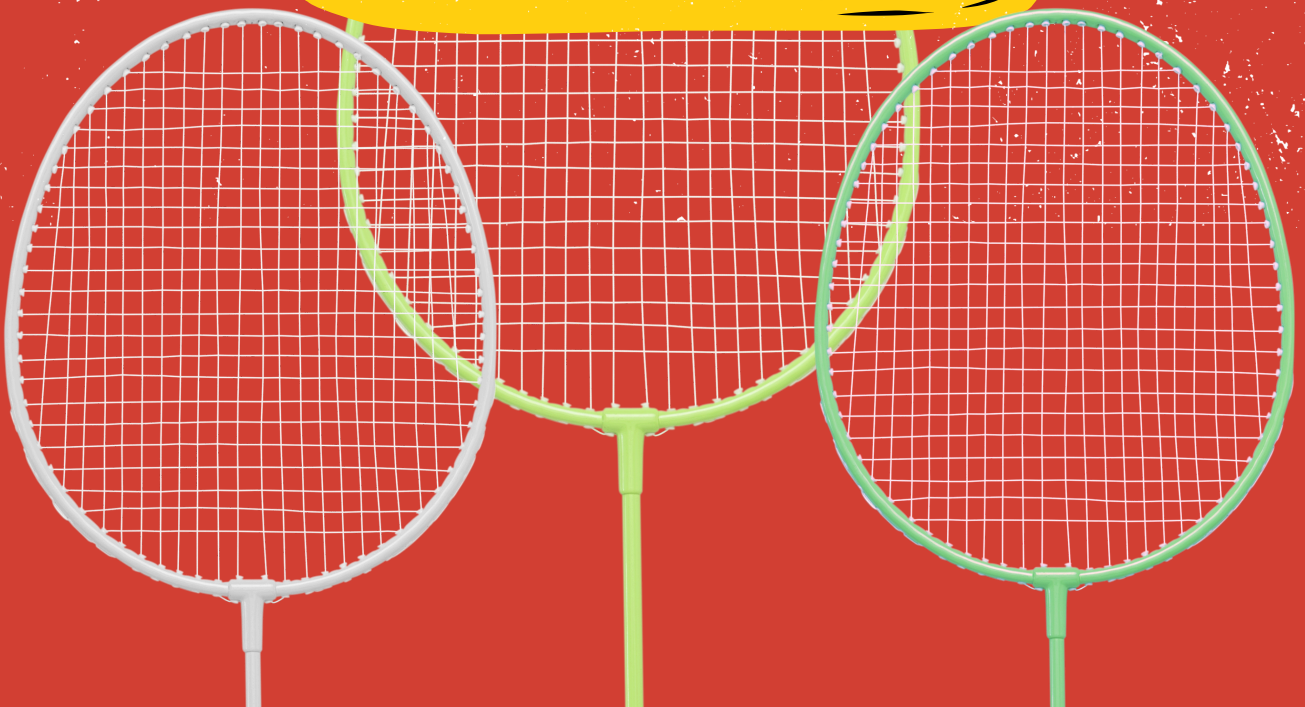
If it exceeds 28 mph and/or has more than 750 watts of power, it is an e-moto. These require a driver's license, registration, and insurance. They are prohibited on bike paths and sidewalks.

- Remove snow from sidewalks adjacent to property
- Maintain privacy or good neighbor fencing on property
  - If you are unsure if you are responsible for fencing, contact the DRC/HOA Management Team.
- Continue doing your part to keep Meridian Ranch a beautiful place to live by following the community guidelines!

If you have a dead tree/shrub or a property landscape issue, report it to the DRC/HOA first and request time to resolve it.

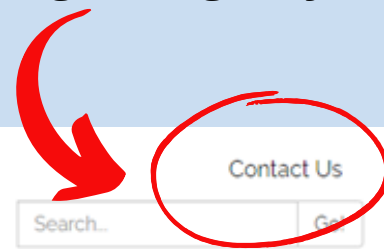
The Lodge at Stonebridge is for Stonebridge HOA owners and tenants only. The maintenance and management of the Lodge is paid through the monthly assessment.
